**Minutes of the Special meeting called by the HOA President to discuss the hosting of the Omnium Bike Race through Pinon Hills**

The meeting was held at the home of Shirley Detmer.

**Officers Present:** Asa Geiger – President, James Bonga – Vice President, Shirley Detmer - Secretary/Treasurer

**Guests:** Angela Damman, Executive Director of the American Cycling Association, Southern Division, Greg Justis, Bill Donovan, Dick and Mary Cuyler, - residents of Pinon Hills.

Angela presented the plan for the bicycle race through Pinon Hills which would be held on Sunday August 1, 2010. The race would start at approximately 7:30 A.M. and finish on or before 6:30 P.M. the same day. The starting point would be at Scanga Meats parking lot, proceed up CR156 to Pinon Hills, turning left on W Cherokee Cir, around to E Cherokee Cir and then left on CR156, over to CR175, down CR175 to CR135, turning right and proceeding back to CR156 and finish up at Scangas. A barbecue would be held for the racers at the Scanga parking lot after the race. Parking for the spectators would be set up on C.R. 152. Five hundred racers of various age groups will be represented in races throughout the day. Angela stated that the racing association carries insurance for all the racing events.

Furthermore, Angela stated that her organization is in the process of getting race site approval from the American Cycling Association; she said the approval is 95% assured. Angela is also in the process of getting approval from the County and the City of Salida. She assured everyone that ACA will have volunteers to cleanup all debris related to the race. This cleanup also includes preparing the roads for the race. ACA volunteers will also sweep up loose dirt, gravel and asphalt, as deemed necessary, before the race. Bill Donovan volunteered to take charge of the cleanup committee. He also announced that all information concerning the race will be addressed in his locally produced newspaper, The Salida Citizen as well as [www.pinonhills.org](http://www.pinonhills.org).

Asa asked what would be expected of the Pinon Hills HOA if we agreed to host the event. Angela requested that we contact all residents in Pinon Hills with information regarding the race course and relay to them the rules and all information so that they will support the events of the day in a positive way. There will be a need for volunteers at specific road intersections if HOA members are interested. Angela also asked that all homeowners make sure their dogs are not running loose that day. The ACA will need to get us brochures as soon as possible so that we can distribute them throughout the neighborhood.

All present unanimously agreed that hosting the Salida Omnium in Pinon Hills would be a good way to bring all the neighbors together and create a positive experience for the neighborhood. All present were in favor of holding the event in Pinon Hills.
